

Update: Woman dies in RV crash on Highway 141 near Egnar



Also, San Miguel sheriff seeks help in robbery investigation

A woman died in a single-vehicle crash on Colorado Highway 141 north of Egnar Thursday morning, according to the Colorado State Patrol.

The large motor home crashed into a guardrail and overturned at mile marker 19, according to the preliminary report.

The victim became pinned and died at the scene, said Master Trooper Gary Cutler. Emergency crews used extrication equipment during the rescue effort.

The highway was closed after the crash, according to the State Patrol. It occurred just before 9 a.m. in a winding section of road. The cause of the crash is under investigation. The identify of the woman has not been released.

A wrecker has been called in to begin removing the vehicle. Drivers should expect closures and delays.

Emergency crews and the Colorado State Patrol, Egnar and Dove Creek Fire departments responded to the crash.
